

Objectives:

1. To share experiences of people's sufferings whose nations are victims of US intervention, aggression and hegemonic wars
2. To share the roles being played by their governments concerning this issue
3. To share peoples' responses, organized or otherwise, including those being done by churches, faith-based organizations, NGOs and advocates, and their impact on the issue
4. To discuss and agree on possible doable programme of action of churches and faith-based organizations
5. To add the voice and strength of the ecumenical community to the broadening people's movements working for freedom, justice and peace through a Conference Unity Statement
6. To conduct an ecumenical and interfaith outdoor action to express our prophetic denunciation of US militarism and intervention, and to announce our message of love, justice and peace
